



### ***brushes & markers***

Depending on the brush marker or paint brush size, each type of tip will give you slightly different looking letters. When mixing paint with water, you want to achieve a consistency so that your colors go from saturated to translucent as you move your brush across the paper. This can be adjusted with more or less water until you reach the perfect mixture!



### ***basic strokes***

The lines you make to form the letter shapes in hand lettering are called strokes. Every time your hand moves **UP** your paper, you'll be applying the lightest possible touch to your brush for the **THIN** lines. Every time your hand moves **DOWN** your paper, apply **HEAVY** pressure to your brush for thick lines. Every single letter has both thick and thin sides.
